

Mathematics

We will be consolidating their knowledge on place value to 50 and addition & subtraction to 20. Then moving on to counting forwards and backwards in multiples of 2, 5 and 10. We will consolidate 2D and 3D shapes and investigate Maths in real life contexts.

Music

With Mrs Broadbent the children will do the following; listening, appraising, musical activities, interrelated dimensions of music with main themes of Western Classical music and creativity.

PSHE

The children will be looking at 'Relationships' and thinking about their emotions and behaviours. They will consider how their behaviour affects themselves and others as well as learning how to listen and communicate effectively.

History

This term we will be finding out about famous people; including Florence Nightingale, Mary Seacole, Neil Armstrong, Tim Peake and Beatrix Potter.

RE

We will have an RE day each half term. They will be learning about the Christian celebration of Pentecost in Summer 1 and prayers and blessing relating to Judaism in Summer 2.

Art and DT

We will be producing different textures using a variety of media including pencil. We will also be looking at shapes in our natural environment and using these to make a 3d sculpture.

This term the children will be making designing and making a fruit salad.

English

Over the term the children will be exploring different genres of literature including story writing, letters, fact files and animal stories.

Children will take part in regular phonics, spelling and reading sessions (both group / choral reading and whole class reading focusing on comprehension).

Although the Year One national phonics screening will not take place in 2021 pupils will still experience reading and writing real and 'alien' words to consolidate their understanding of phonics.

Science

We will learn the names of animals, including pets, and sort them according to diet, variety and shape. Children will name parts of common animals and explain how a body part reflects how it uses it's senses.

Pupils will spend time in our woods observing and learning about weather and the seasons.

Computing

Over the term we will be using the internet to search safely and share facts. The children will be introduced to coding and learn how to write algorithms to program a character to move.

P.E

Our Dance sessions will focus on the rainforest and pupils will be able to make individual and whole class dance sequences. Athletics and multi skills will be the focus for outdoor P.E. lessons.

Home learning

Please continue to hear your child read regularly (5 x a week) at home and learn to read and spell their keywords.

Practise number bonds for 10 & 20 and counting to and from 100.

These non-compulsory tasks are linked to our topics and will extend your child's learning.

Read 10 books from our Greatest Reads list.

Use your drawing skills to draw and label an animal of your choice. Use the internet to research a famous person and tell us about them.
