

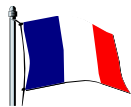
Year 3 Summer Term 2021

Year 3 will be learning the 6 & 9 times tables, as well as revising 3, 5, 10, 2, 4 & 8. We will be learning more about multiplication and fractions as well as consolidating fluency of basic number facts.



English

We will be learning to use inverted commas whilst writing adventure stories. We will also learn to use connectives in non-narrative writing linked to our history topic.



French

This term we will learn how to name parts of the body and days of the week.

Computing



We will be learning to consolidate our digital literacy skills, as well as introducing emails.

RE

We will learn about a fourth religion (Judaism) this term, before returning to Christianity. With both religions, we will be looking at beliefs in action.



Music

Listening, appraising, musical activities, interrelated dimensions of music with a main focus on Western Classical music plus a song about friendship, peace, hope and unity.
