**English** – We will be reading a variety of genres including instructions and information texts. Our work on shape poems and calligrams will link with computing.

**Mathematics** – Year 3 are focusing on the 8 times tables and the corresponding division facts then the 3 times tables, as well as the ones they already know (2, 4, 5, 10). Homework will be to practise these as they will be tested regularly for speed and accuracy. Our lessons will focus on multiplication and division.



## Spring Term - KS2

Trips and Visitors - [Hadleigh land use walk.



**Computing** – [The children will be developing their Digital Literacy skills as well as using algorithms to code in Computer Science. Online Safety will also be referred to throughout the term.]

**R.E.** – [We will be learning about Hinduism and in Christianity we will be looking at symbolism leading up to Easter.]

Art/DT - [The children will be telling stories through drawing and making focusing on 3D art. Whilst in D.T, they will be making mittens for the class mascot.]

**Science** – [This term the children will be learning about the topic of forces as well as beginning to learn about plants.]

**Geography** – [The children will be learning to use maps and atlases to compare a polar climate to our own temperate climate. There will also be links to computing and English.]

**Homework** — [You could help by hearing your child read regularly and talking about the book they have read. We learn spelling patterns and phonics. Homework will be to learn these spellings and they will be tested on words that are often misspelt. Homework will also be to reinforce times tables and other number facts as they will be tested regularly for speed and accuracy.]

**Primary Languages** — [This term pupils will move on to learning to name objects in the class and colours.]

**P.E.** – [Pupils will be working on invasion and striking/fielding games, focusing on key skills such as support play, scoring goals and basic batting/fielding techniques.

**P.S.H.E.** – [This term the children are discussing 'Living in the Wider World'.]

**Music** – [Pupils will spend the first half of this term learning about Indian Classical music through a series of practical workshops. The second half of the term will focus on Tchaikovsky's ballet 'Swan Lake'
