Snack and Water Bottles

Warmer Weather

As we are now in the Summer Term, can you please ensure your child has sun cream applied (if necessary) **before** Nursery and they have a named sun hat with them. Please remember no open toe or heeled shoes as these are impractical for outdoor play, climbing and P.E. Thank you.



Forest School Clothes

Our Forest School sessions will continue as normal. Although the weather will hopefully be warmer, please bear in mind that it is significantly cooler in the woods so please remember a jumper and coat. **We would recommend:**

- Long trousers to minimise scratches, stings and possible marks from tree and rope climbing. We will happily change your child if they need to come in wearing shorts (or change them after their session), just pop a pair of trousers into their bag and let us know.
- A pair of old trainers will be fine unless it is raining.
- Old clothes– remember we will still get muddy (and smelly!)
