The school will try to:-

- care for your child's safety and happiness and aim to contact parents if there are any concerns.
- provide a broad and balanced curriculum at an appropriate level for your child.
- Keep you informed about your child's progress at regular intervals.
- offer your child opportunities to extend their learning and experience in clubs, visits, special events.
- provide a clean, tidy, efficient and pleasant environment in which to learn.

The parents/family will try to:-

- ensure that their child attends school regularly, on time and with appropriate uniform and equipment
- contact the school as soon as possible if their child is unable to attend
- make the school aware of any concerns or problems that might affect their school work and behaviour
- ensure that any changes to medical conditions or contact details are updated
- attend Parents' Evenings, and other school events in order to keep in touch with school life
- engage with their child's homework; especially reading regularly during term time
- support the school's efforts to use online communications
- support the school by paying for school meals, visit contributions and other payments by the school's online payment system
- support the school by paying dinner money/Nursery Lunch Club and Wrap Around Care monies promptly – if dinner money is more than a week in arrears, then the school will be unable to serve further meals until the debt is cleared

The child will try to:-

- enjoy school and help others to enjoy their time at school
- concentrate and work hard in lesson time and complete homework tasks
- help to keep the school clean and tidy
- have the right equipment in school each day
- listen and follow out instructions from their teacher and parents
- regulate and discuss their emotions within the school setting

Together we will:-

- work to support your child if they have any additional needs
- support and encourage the children to do their best and reach for the stars to make their time at school productive and enjoyable
- be open and honest and treat each other with kindness and respect
