Hadleigh Community Primary School (HCPS) takes seriously its responsibility for keeping all members of its community safe. Staff, volunteers and visitors are all made aware of their legal responsibilities to put the welfare and safety of all pupils at the forefront of what they do.

If you have any concerns about the welfare of a pupil at HCPS you must ask to speak to the Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL). Mrs Eluned Beaumont-George holds this post and co-ordinates all aspects of this work. She is supported by the Alternate DSL's, Mrs Joanne Deaves and Mr Ashley Betts to whom you should approach in the absence of the DSL. If the concern relates to online safety then Mrs Eluned Beaumont-George should be contacted.

Our school is one where pupils feel secure and are encouraged to talk freely if they are worried or concerned about something in or out of school, safe in the knowledge that they will be listened to and the appropriate action will ALWAYS be pursued vigorously.

You will need to wear your visitor badge at all times whilst on the school site. This also contains information about Safeguarding as well as the fire evacuation procedure if the alarms were to sound during your time with us.
