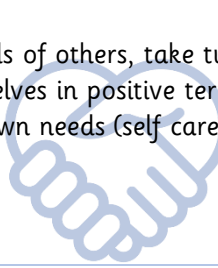




Autumn Term – Reception

Manage their own needs (self care).



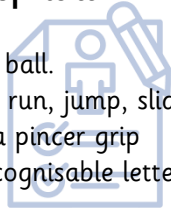
Communication & Language

Orally retell stories.



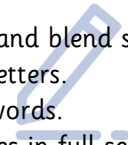
Physical Development

Begin to form recognisable letters.



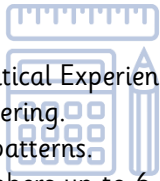
Literacy

Write their own name.



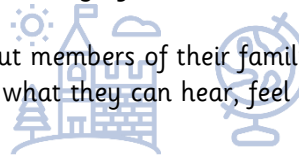
Maths

Explore one more and one fewer within 6.

Describe what they can hear, feel and see in the natural world.



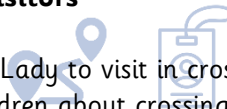
Expressive Arts & Design

Express own ideas and feelings.



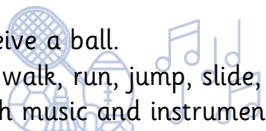
Trips and Visitors
