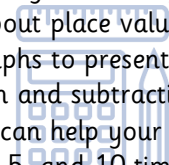


English – [The type of fiction texts we will be reading and writing will be the mystery genre, with a focus on story setting. Poetry Day will be celebrated in October and later in the term we will be learning a poem to recite by heart.]



Mathematics – [We will be consolidating our knowledge of single digit and 2-digit numbers. We will be learning more about place value of 3-digit numbers as well as different graphs to present data. This will be followed by addition and subtraction as well as length and perimeter. You can help your child with consolidating the 2- 5- and 10-times tables & learning 4 times table after half term.]

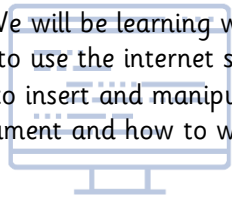


Autumn Term - KS2

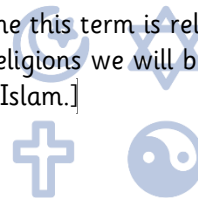
Trips and Visitors – [We also hope to visit Bury St Edmunds cathedral (TBC) to link with our work in RE.]



Computing – [We will be learning what a network is and how to use the internet safely. We will also be learning how to insert and manipulate text and pictures in a document and how to write code.]

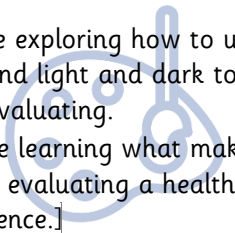


R.E. – [Our theme this term is religion and the individual. The religions we will be learning about are Christianity and Islam.]

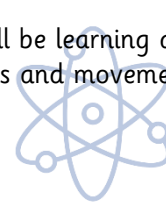


Art – [We will be exploring how to use charcoal, different marks and light and dark tones to create sketches before evaluating.]

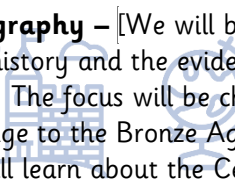
D.T. – We will be learning what makes a healthy meal by designing and evaluating a healthy pasta salad which links with our science.]



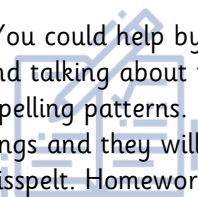
Science – [We will be learning about fossils, nutrition and diet, skeletons and movement.]



History & Geography – [We will be learning about chronology, pre-history and the evidence that tells us how people lived. The focus will be changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Bronze Age and to the Iron Age where we will learn about the Celts.]



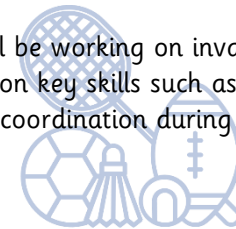
Homework – [You could help by hearing your child read regularly and talking about the book they have read. We learn spelling patterns. Homework will be to learn these spellings and they will be tested on words that are often misspelt. Homework will also be to reinforce times tables and other number facts as they will be tested regularly for speed and accuracy.]



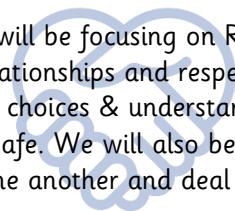
Primary Languages – [We will be focusing on learning about France, pronunciation and how to greet new people in French.]



P.E. – Pupils will be working on invasion and net style games, focusing on key skills such as keeping possession, using space and coordination during tennis.]



P.S.H.E. – [We will be focusing on Relationships and Families, Safe relationships and respecting ourselves. Making informed choices & understanding that there are rules to keep us safe. We will also be learning how to get along with one another and deal with bullying.]



Music – [Pupils will be introduced to the elements of music: Metre, Tempo, Harmony, Instrumentation, Pitch, Structure, Expression and Rhythm, before moving onto learning about Blues music and learning to play a Blues song on the ukulele. Towards the end of the term, we will be preparing for our annual Carol Service at St Mary's Church.]
