

Dear Parents/Carers

On Thursday 26th March we are planning to take the children on a visit to Broom Hill Nature Reserve in Hadleigh. We will have a fun morning of bug hunting, den building and looking for signs of spring.

In order to make things easier and to save a large group of children walking too far, could you please bring your child to the parking area on the right just past Toppesfield Bridge for 9.00a.m.

If your child normally stays just for the morning please can you pick up from the same parking area at 12.00p.m. If your child is here all day then we will walk them back to Nursery for lunch. **There will be no school dinners available so please provide your child with a packed lunch.** Please note there will still be a charge as we have to pay for the lunchtime staff as normal.

The trip will be run by the Nursery Team, thank you but parent helpers won't be required.

There is no charge for this trip. We will take the children's medication with us from school. We will provide a mid-morning snack as usual, please can your child bring a water bottle. If you would like your child to wear their puddle suit or wellie boots from the woods, please ask for it via Tapestry **before Wednesday 25th March** and we will get them ready for you.

Things to Remember

- Please meet in the parking area on the right past **Toppesfield Bridge at 9.00a.m.**
- Remember old, warm clothes, a coat (or snowsuit) and old trainers or wellies
- Please make sure your child has been to the toilet before meeting us!
- A water bottle
- **No toys or bags please unless your child is in nappies** (we will take plenty of spare clothes)
- **Pick up is at 12.00pm** from the parking area unless your child is with us all day.
- **Packed lunch** if your child is here all day please!
