


English – We will be reading a variety of information texts linking to our work in Science and Geography. We will also be reading and writing poetry.




Spring Term - KS2

Trips and Visitors – [Hadleigh land use walk. Hadleigh rock walk]






R.E. – [We will be learning about Hinduism and Humanism.]






Science – [Focusing on Rocks and Soil. Following on from this, children will be learning about Forces and Magnets.]



Geography – [The children will be learning to use maps and atlases to compare a polar climate to our own temperate climate. There will also be links to computing and English.]






Primary Languages – [Children will be learning about the names of the animals and then learning the French words for instruments.]
